



# 2021 ZESTINO TIRES NSW SUPERSPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

## PART 2

# 2.1 Two Competitions

These Supplementary Regulations are for a single event that includes two (2) competitions, which are a State Competition being a Round of the NSW State Supersprint Championship ("the Championship") and a Multi-Club Competition being a Multi-Club Supersprint ("the Multi-Club Supersprint"). All of the Supplementary Regulations apply equally to both competitions with the exception of those regulations that specifically state that they apply to just one or the other.

# 2.6 Track

**Surface:** Bitumen / Length: 2.8 kms / Direction: Anticlockwise / Boundary: Drivers who drive off the competition surface as defined by the solid line on the outer edge of the track with all 4 wheels will be deemed to have left the circuit and may have their lap times for that session forfeited.

#### 2.9 Number of Laps

Each run will comprise a minimum time to allow all competitors to complete at least 3 timed laps, with the time for the fastest single lap being used for results. The minimum time for each run will be 8 Minutes. The proposed minimum number of runs on the day will be: 4

(Note: The Event will not be concluded when this minimum is achieved. Event will only be concluded early for safety reasons or if no competitors available)

#### 2.10 Entries

- a) Maximum number of Driver entries for the Event: 120 Reserves: 10
- b) Maximum number of Drivers per car 2. Dual entry of drivers in Type 1 will be at the discretion of the organising club.
- c) Drivers must be a financial member of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club on the date of the Event.
- d) Vehicles competing in the NSW Supersprint Championship must either be currently road registered (incl. Historic & Classic) and/or be issued with a Motorsport Australia log book.
- e) Vehicles in the Multi Club Supersprint will not be eligible to score Championship points and must run under a competition number in the 900 999 range.
- f) Preferential Opening Date for Championship Registrants: 26th July 2021
- g) General Opening Date: 9th August 2021
- h) Entry Fee \$ NSWRRC Members \$220, Non Members \$270. Entries received by 25th August \$20 additional discount
- i) Event Cancellation: A full refund will be given to all competitors if the event is cancelled, please allow 28 days for refunds to be processed as the organisers first need refunds from track hire, services and permit fee outlays.
- j) Timing Transponder hire if required \$ 15 plus gst (\$16.50)
- k) Entry Closing Date: 10th September 2021 Late Entry Closing Date: 17th September 2021
- I) A Late Entry Fee of \$25.00 will apply for entries received after the Entry closing date. Late entries will be placed at the back of their respective grid group.
- m) A pit usage fee of \$ 20 per garage (2 car spaces per garage) will apply. Carports \$ Nil .
- n) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt electronically together with the appropriate payment as required.
- o) Entries from Drivers 14 years to 17 years of age inclusive must have the consent of a parent or legal guardian submitted by the parent of guardian using online form **SSP 09PG Parent/Guardian Consent**.

#### 2.11 Event Schedule

There will be no in-person document checks. Documents (Declarations etc.) <u>must be received electronically no later than two days after the Event Closing Date</u> and will be checked prior to the event.

Event Start time: 9:00 am (Gates open at 7:00 am) Event Finish time: 4:30 pm

#### 2.12 Drivers Code of Conduct

Penalties for breaches of the Drivers Code of Conduct included in SSP 02 Sporting Regulations may apply.

## 2.13 Scrutineering

- a) There will be pre-event scrutineering at the Circuit of Multi Club vehicles described in clause 2.10 (e) above and of vehicles that are not registered to gain points in the State Championship. These vehicles will be allocated a competition number between 900 and 999.
- A self-scrutiny vehicle safety check must be performed by all competitors whose vehicles do not have a Motorsport Australia Log Book. The Check List to be used to record this is included in online form SSP 09C Competitor/Owner Risk Warning, Disclaimer, Indemnity & Statement of Vehicle Compliance.
- c) Vehicles that have a Motorsport Australia Log Book will be subject to the Targeted Scrutiny system.

Competitors must present themselves to Scrutineering with their Helmet, Log Book and Proof of Vehicle Registration (as applicable) to have their Scrutineering windscreen sticker issued.

Please note that scrutineers may conduct checks through the day whilst maintaining distancing and non-contact protocols. If a non-compliance is found the Driver/Competitor may be referred to the Clerk of the Course.

## 2.17 COVID-19 Special Conditions

- a) Under no circumstances may anyone attend an event if any of the following apply:
  - Have any symptoms consistent with COVD-19 such as higher temperature, respiratory issues, shortness of breath, sore throat, lack of sense of small, fatigue
  - b. Been overseas in the previous 14 days
  - c. Been in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days
- b) Spectators are permitted.
- c) All attendees must check in using the Circuit's Service NSW QR Code app prior to venue entry.
- d) Sharing of tools, equipment and apparel is to be avoided. If sharing is unavoidable, the equipment must be cleaned prior to use by another person.
- e) The sharing of food is to be avoided.
- f) Social distancing as required by Governments is to be maintained.
- g) The COVID-19 Event Checker will be Kieran Pradeep
- h) Comply with any requests by the COVID-19 Event Checker.
- i) Other conditions: N/A
